March 1st, 2012 marks the official launch of Signs for Hope *going public!* This is probably the single most important decision we have ever made; the decision to share the full-time support of this ministry with you, our friends. This simply means we are actively seeking not only your continued prayer support for me and this ministry, but we are also seeking financial support from those of you who feel led to join with us—in an ongoing effort—to reach out to the Deaf/HOH orphans around the world.

The Signs for Hope vision is giving hope to these precious children through adoption and/or sponsorship (heart adoption) with the ultimate goal of sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ with them in their heart language—sign language. The [Fall 2011 Newsletter](#) outlines, in detail, the ways Signs for Hope seeks to give hope to Deaf/HOH orphans and the families God leads to adopt and/or sponsor them. Recently, it became overwhelmingly clear, to Charles and to me, that we can no longer fund Signs for Hope 'out of our own pockets'. Instead, God has revealed that we are to share this great opportunity, to fulfill the Great Commission, with each of you in a more tangible way. The goal is to reach 100% full-support by May 24th—the departure date for the Liberia 2012 trip.

We received our *how to* training for embarking on this new adventure at the [Support Raising Solutions](#) "boot camp" in Birmingham, AL February 15 and 16. What an enlightening experience this was, especially as we delved deeply into those scriptural truths directly related to how His Church—brothers and sisters in Christ—become co-laborers with those called into His full-time Kingdom's work, not only through prayer but through financially supporting them, as well.

So what does this mean exactly? It means we, Charles and Becky Lloyd, are officially launching Signs for Hope as the full-blown ministry God has enlarged it to become. The initial budget for Signs for Hope is based on what my expenses have been over the past 3 years, as I followed God's lead to discover what His call truly meant and then adding those opportunities God has already opened the door for me to be involved in during 2012.
